### ADDITIONAL SERVICES

The tuition fee includes English as an Additional Language (EAL) support. However, certain specialized services, such as Individual Learning Assistance (ILA) and Occupational Therapy, are not covered under the tuition fee and will incur additional charges on a semester basis. In some cases, these services may be a condition for enrollment to ensure the school can adequately support the student's learning needs.

### TRANSPORTATION FEE

Transportation (air-condition, adult monitored & two-way only) is provided for designated routes at the following rates:

### PRO-RATING TUITION and TRANSPORTATION FEES

Full tuition fees on a per semester basis are charged after a student has been at ISB for 50 school days. Up to that time ISB will charge 2% of the per semester tuition fee per day. Transportation fees are charged based on the no. of days of each semester and will be prorated based upon the number of days of attendance.

**In the event of circumstances not foreseen when fees were set, the Board of Trustees reserves the right to increase or revise fees at any time during the school year.**
